More specifically, the focus will be on 1) a typical career path, 2) approximate salary range, and 3) a personal interview with someone in the community who is in each of the careers. The interview will involve general questions about the job, the work-life balance, stress level, challenges, and other relevant career matters. In each case, I will do some pre-research about the careers prior to visiting with the professional for the interview and identify more questions in the research process.

The final project will be a 15 page, typewritten documented report formatted according to APA style. The interviews will be the focus of the report in which I will discuss each career examined and an explanation of which careers may be of interest to me after graduation, and why.
