The journal will include your personal reactions, reflections, and observations, as well as a summary of what you gained from this travel experience. Your travel experience should be documented with other written materials, photos, and memorabilia.
 - ~ The semester after you travel and return to the University of Nevada, Reno, you must register for HON 410, submit your journal, and participate in an Honors international study seminar.
